

Installing 2Simple Software on Mac

All 2Simple Mac programs are supported on 10.4, 10.5 and 10.6. Some are also supported on older OS's - see below for a full list.

Steps to install:

1. Make sure you have the latest version of **Adobe Flash Player** installed from www.adobe.com. You also need Adobe Reader to view the user guides.
2. Create a new folder on the computer (e.g. on the Desktop, or the Applications folder)
3. Insert the cd, select the appropriate folder and drag and drop it into the new folder on your computer.
 - Mac Collection: Each program has its own folder on the dvd.
 - Individual s/w cds: On hybrid cds which contain installs for both Mac and PC, there will be a folder named MAC which you need to select. Otherwise simply select the entire contents of the cd.
4. Double-click all hqx & zip files to extract them. If you are unable to extract the hqx files, install Stuffit Expander from www.stuffit.com/mac .
5. Double-click on the program icon to launch the program, except Talking Stories and the IVT Videos which are launched from html files.

FAQ

Q: I unzipped the zip file on my pc and copied the files across to my mac and it won't work

A: Any zip files for any of the programs need to be unzipped directly on a mac.

Q: Do you have actual installations for your mac programs?

A: No, we do not. All our mac programs are "installed" simply by copying them to your computer from cd and unzipping any zipped up files.

Q: How do I uninstall 2Simple programs on mac?

A: Simply delete the relevant files. There are no "installers" or "uninstallers" for 2Simple programs on mac.

Q: Which 2Simple programs work on Mac?

A: See www.2simple.com > support > most recent versions. Some software is available online and some is available on cd. Currently the list is:

- **Swf files:** Four 2Simple programs which run on Windows only nonetheless have the ability to create swf Flash files – and these flash files can be run on Macs – these programs are [2Create](#), [2Create a Story](#), [2Create a Superstory](#) and [2Do It Yourself](#).
- **Boot camp / virtualization** - Finally, you may be able to run 2Simple's other programs which are Windows-only on your mac, using one of the following methods (1) Many mac computers have the ability to boot up into Windows at startup, or (2) Use virtualization software. See <http://store.apple.com/uk/browse/guide/windows> for more info.

Q: Does 2Simple software require Rosetta to run on Mac?

A: Yes, it does. The only exceptions to this currently are browser-based versions of the following programs (contact 2Simple for a copy of these) : [2Type](#), [Literacy Collection](#), [Simple City](#), [Talking Stories](#) and the online programs ([Online Package A](#), [2Simple French](#), [Maths City 2](#), [Maths Games 1](#), [Stories 2 Tell](#)). The only difference with the browser-based versions is that you cannot save changes within the teacher options – you need to edit the settings xml file directly.
