[Infant Toolkit](#), [2Investigate](#), [Modelling Toolkit](#), [Alphabet Soup](#) – these 4 programs require Rosetta to run. Since the latest Mac OS 10.7 (“Lion”) does not include or support Rosetta, these programs will not work on 10.7. We are looking into possible solutions for this. Note that Infant Toolkit and 2Investigate are also available as part of our website www.purplemash.com which means you can run them on v10.7 if you subscribe to Purple Mash. Another option to consider is to use boot camp / virtualization to run an older Mac OS or even a Windows OS – these options would allow continued use of the above 4 programs. We apologize for any difficulty this causes - please contact us to discuss further.

The other 2Simple mac programs - [2Simulate](#), [2Type](#), [Literacy Collection](#), [Math City 1](#), [Simple City](#), [Stories 2 Tell](#) – are flash-based and do not require Rosetta, so will work on 10.7. However, some CD versions of these programs are out of date and you’ll need to contact 2Simple for the latest download links.

Our creative online space [Purple Mash \(www.purplemash.com\)](http://www.purplemash.com) will work on 10.7.

Steps to install:

1. Make sure you have the latest version of **Adobe Flash Player** installed from www.adobe.com. You also need Adobe Reader to view the user guides.
2. Create a new folder on the computer (e.g. on the Desktop, or the Applications folder)
3. Insert the cd, select the appropriate folder and drag and drop it into the new folder on your computer.
 - a. Mac Collection: Each program has its own folder on the dvd.
 - b. Individual cds: On hybrid cds which contain installs for both Mac and PC, there will be a folder named MAC which you need to select. Otherwise simply select the entire

contents of the cd.

4. Double-click all hqx & zip files to extract them. If you are unable to extract the hqx files, install Stuffit Expander from www.stuffit.com/mac.
 5. Double-click on the program icon or HTML file to launch the program.

FAQ

Q: I have Infant Toolkit on Mac and it does not work since I have updated to OS 10.6.

A: Make sure you have Rosetta installed. Rosetta is an optional install for the OS 10.6 so it may not be installed on your computer.

Q: Can I run the Windows based 2Simple programs on a mac?

A: Yes you can, using one of the following methods:

- (1) Many mac computers have the ability to boot up into Windows at startup, or
- (2) Use virtualization software; see <http://store.apple.com/uk/browse/guide/windows> for more info.

Q: I unzipped the zip file on my pc and copied the files across to my mac and it won't work

A: Any zip files for any of the programs need to be unzipped directly on a mac.

Q: Do you have actual installations for your mac programs?

A: No, we do not. All our mac programs are "installed" simply by copying them to your computer from cd and unzipping any zipped up files.

Q: How do I uninstall 2Simple programs on mac?

A: Simply delete the relevant files. There are no "installers" or "uninstallers" for 2Simple programs on mac.
